  - Freshmen: 3.5 High School GPA
  - Lower-Division Transfer: 3.5 HS GPA and 3.5 cumulative GPA in all transferable credits attempted
  - Upper-Division Transfer: 3.5 cumulative GPA in all transferable credits attempted.
5. Live on campus for the first full academic year

- Pay \$70 (U.S.) application fee.
- Official transcripts and proof of an accredited bachelor's degree. Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 or 3.0 for some programs is required.
- English translations are required for non-English documents.
- Language Proficiency (must meet one):
  - TOEFL Score of 550/PBT or 79/IBT
  - Duolingo 105
  - IELTS score of 6.0\*
  - Pass Level 4 of CSUSB's English Language Program
- Meet additional program requirements when applicable.
- Submit a photocopy of the page in your passport that contains your official name and date of birth.
- Submit evidence of adequate financial/bank statement.

## Conditional Admissions\*

CSUSB offers conditional admission to students who do not currently meet the English proficiency requirement through the English Language Program.
